POSITION DESCRIPTION

Background:

Boulder Co. Christchurch is a large commercial indoor bouldering facility, fitness gym and cafe/bar located in Riccarton, Christchurch.

Boulder Co. provides a fun and safe environment to experience world class climbing and to socialise with an active local and international community.

Route Setters, in collaboration with the Manager, are responsible for producing world class, safe and fun boulder problems for Boulder Co. Christchurch.

- The **Head Route Setter** role is offered as a part-time position:
One day per week (day TBD)
- The position is located at **Boulder Co. Christchurch, 179 Blenheim Road, Riccarton, Christchurch**
- This position reports to the **Gym Manager and Directors**.

Roles and Responsibilities:

Responsibilities for the role will include, but not be restricted to:

- Leading and working as part of a team to design and set high-quality, safe boulder problems.
- Working within the Safety Management Plan to ensure the setting process is conducted safely, and that boulders are safe for the public.
- Ensuring Boulder Co. Christchurch stays within the parameters of grades and styles as part of the Boulder Co. setting framework.
- Using provided apps and tracking methods to record, collect and analyze setting data and statistics and report them to the Manager and Directors.
- Aid with the ordering of new holds and volumes as required.
- Organizing and cleaning climbing holds and equipment.
- Assisting with cleaning and general maintenance of the facility where needed.
- Contributing to a positive workplace culture by supporting other members of staff in their daily operations.
- Working within a safety management plan and exercising industry leading safe work practices.
- Ensuring sign off on each set is completed by the Manager prior to customers being permitted to climb.
- Developing and maintaining relationships and goodwill with customers, suppliers and stakeholders.

Essential Skills and Experience:

- **Passion for the industry** - Ideal applicants will be keen members of the global climbing community and have a passion for the sport of bouldering and the growth of the industry.
- **Commercial setting experience** - Proven experience setting commercially appropriate indoor problems to a high and safe standard suitable for a commercial facility.
- **Competition setting experience** - Proven experience setting competition appropriate indoor problems to a high and safe standard suitable for a commercial facility.
- **Safety adherence** - Experience of working under a safety management system which takes all practicable steps to avoid injury to customers, staff and public. Capable of recognising and neutralizing hazards in a climbing and fitness environment.
- **Organisational and Data skills** - Able to organise a team of setters to ensure efficient setting. Able to collect, analyze, interpret and use climb data provided by the customers and gym.
- **Team player** - Excel at working collaboratively with others and actioning team goals.
- **Exceptional interpersonal skills** – Provide positive, and industry leading interaction with customers, staff and vendors.
- **Current first aid certificate** - Able to deal with incidents and emergencies in an educated and professional manner.
- **NZ Resident or Work Visa Holder.**
